On reflection, Habitat for Humanity Egypt work during the first two quarters of our financial year - FY19 (1st July – 31st December, 2019), we have supported 1145 families to have a decent and affordable shelter ,

HFHE had achieved a very successful work camp global village for 1 day with First Presbyterian Church, the volunteers contributed with their efforts and money to help the poor families in El Miniya.

In cooperation between HFH Egypt and HFH Germany, a proposal has been submitted to Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy GmbH & Co. KG and ENGIE.

HFHE will have a work camp for 2 days during next March 2019 with the New Cairo British School, students will participate as volunteers to help the poor families in Miniya Governorate

An initiative with the National Council for Women trying to find opportunities for cooperation with them.

‘ I am feeling safe now with my 2 daughters’

50 years old Safia – a widow and has 2 daughters (in different education stages) lives in Dawalta village Beni suief . They were living in an old house 50m consists of 2 rooms , bathroom and kitchen all built with raw bricks , full of insects and snakes.

She had faced many trials to break in the house from strangers. As all there were no walls and doors to the house rooms which was not safe at all to her daughters .Her monthly income is 750 LE which is not enough to rebuild and renovate her house again.

After a long period of living with her two daughters in anxiety and fear . Habitat Egypt Contributed in offering her a loan and helped in the change of her life totally . She built the walls and the roof and she installed 2 wooden doors to the house rooms. And her house is now safe and secure.
